We are greatly indebted to the crew of the air ambulance and aim to show our gratitude whenever we can this season

It costs £2700 every time the aircraft is deployed and we have set ourselves the target of raising enough for 2 flights. Your support for this fantastic cause, starting today is much appreciated.

I'M NOT TOO SURE WHERE THE SUMMER WENT BUT HERE WE ARE AT THE BEGINNING OF ANOTHER SEASON AND WHAT A SEASON IT PROMISES TO BE!

The huge celebrations at the end of last season in the wake of our promotion are just memories now as we prepare to meet the challenge of National 1 rugby. Everyone throughout the Club is excited at the prospect and I know that the players just want to get on with it now and so it is that we offer a very warm welcome to today's opposition, Caldy, who were last season's winners of National 2 North. It is good to begin such a momentous season at home and there is a certain irony in the fact that we have been drawn against each other in the first game. Both sides will be desparate to get off to a winning start, so we should be in for a very competitive game.

Hats off to Tubby once again for the quality of the playing surface he has produced, not only on the 1st team pitch but all the Club's pitches, which are looking superb. The Club has invested heavily in renovating the pitches during the close season, together with a rabbit fence around the back pitches, to prevent all his good work being ripped up – literally!



A Potted History of Caldy Rugby Club 1924 – February 27th When some Old Boys of Caldy School, with the encouragement of the then Headmaster, decided that they must carry on playing rugby together so the 'Old Caldeians' R.F.C. came into being at a meeting held at a café in West Kirby. They started playing in a farm field and changing in the farm buildings, bathing facilities were somewhat primitive they used a tin bath which was filled from a tap in the farm Yard.

If that sounds familiar how about this quotation from Caldy's web site: "We have also been awarded the RFU presidents XV Award for our submission "More than a club" which laid out our vision of a "one club ethos" which we feel is the way forward." and continuing:

We had approximately 500 members under 19 including 73 in our under 7's last year. Such is the size of our Youth section the club is now actively seeking ways to increase the size of our playing areas.

The key objectives are:-

- 1. To raise the profile of Rugby in the area
- 2. To provide access to a physical activity for all.
- 3. To increase the numbers participating in Rugby.
- 4. To provide a broad base in the sport this will lead to increased numbers at senior level.
- 5. To provide the right level of coaching to enable the level of skills to improve.
- 6. To provide players who with the skills to benefit rugby at a national level

What encourages the 'rugby spirit' is the similarities between clubs rather than the differences, It sounds like our two Clubs are cut from the same cloth.

On 8 April 2017 Caldy reached the highest level in the club's history when they beat title rivals Sale 28–26 in front of a crowd of 1,432 at Paton Field (the best attendance at the ground in over a decade) to win National League 2 North and gain promotion. For the final home game at Bishop's Stortford the attendance was 1,664 !

Both Clubs approach the new season probably having prepared even more thoroughly but still not knowing quite what to expect. Despite the 'National' title the overall travelling mileage difference for Bishop's Stortford is less than 100 miles in total but some individual journeys could. No doubt, take their toll.

LIKE SOME OTHER SPORTS RUGBY IS STARTING TO DEVELOP DIFFERENT FORMATS OF THE GAME TO BROADEN ITS APPEAL TO A WIDER AUDIENCE, RUGBY 7S IS NOW AN OLYMPIC SPORT; WHEELCHAIR RUGBY WAS IN THE PARA-ATHLETICS; WHILE ANY MINI COACH KNOWS TAG RUGBY IS AN INTRODUCTION FOR KIDS TO RUGBY – BUT THERE ARE THRIVING ADULT TAG RUGBY LEAGUES TOO AND TOUCH RUGBY.

Touch Rugby takes the handling, running lines and strategy of open play in rugby but removes all contact – so no rucks, no mauls, no scrums. The rules and structure of the game mean it is ideal for both sexes to play together.

So it is for BSRFC Touch Group we have about 60 players registered with a regular 25-30 turning up on a Wednesday evening



to play Touch. We have focused on being an open social group so as any age, any ability, any experience (or none at all) are welcome. There is a winter league of other touch clubs in the area with a final usually played on Saracens fantastic 4G Pitch. We regularly take part in day tournaments and host our own in the summer – this year our tournament at BSRFC attended by 10 teams and approx. 300 people. We also go on an international tour every year, last year was France and this year was Portugal, each year the international tour gets bigger as more teams from more countries enter.

The social and fun aspect to the Touch group's Wednesday's where the bar is as important as the pitch has really worked for us as we have brought new people to the club who wouldn't have even given a thought to rugby and the club can retain players who perhaps due to work commitments or age, or level of 'decrepitness' can't play the 15 a side game



but can still actively play touch.

We often hear the comment 'its great to be back playing rugby'. The touch group works the other way too as we have had players move from the touch group to playing in the senior sides and we have touch players in the ladies rugby side too.

...But we also want to focus on how we perform at tournaments and competitive games, so we have started to look at improving our core skills and applying Touch specific strategies to the game so that we can start to develop a 'tournament squad' that are more focused on the competitive side. As with any sport the more we enter competitions the more we learn and the desire to win grows within the group.

It is at this point I should thank the dedicated volunteers to help the group run smoothly and the fantastic support given to us by the club itself both Perry and Colin and the executive which has enabled us to thrive. We have great plans to grow further, incorporate a youth side to perhaps 'catch' those kids that like rugby but dislike contact. Wherever we get to, we will strive to retain the core values that make BSRFC great and retain the fun and social aspect of this great game of rugby (in all its formats).

THE ROAD TO NATIONAL 1

PROFESSIONALISM HAD FOR MANY YEARS BEEN CONSIDERED A TABOO TOPIC WITHIN THE RFU AND THE FORMATION OF LEAGUES WITH PROMOTION AND RELEGATION WAS SEEN AS A SIGN OF PROFESSIONALISM AND TO BE "OUTLAWED".

In the 1960's the Sunday Telegraph published Merit Tables for the leading English Clubs with a Club's position based upon the percentage of matches won against other clubs included with the Table. The 1970's saw the experiments with County Merit Tables and the introduction of a National Cup competition.

Under pressure the RFU finally approved the creation of two national merit tables where clubs had to play a minimum of eight games against other clubs in their division. 1987 was the first formation of a true national league system. Today there are in excess of 1,500 Clubs competing in 101 leagues.

Bishop's Stortford RFC had been playing in the County Merit Tables and gained selection for the national leagues by a fraction over Barnet in what was then London 3 North West. In that first season under the captaincy of Gordon Campbell, Bishop's Stortford won 8 out of 10 of their matches to become Champions and gain promotion into London 2 North where they stayed until 2002-03.

Now with Rob Faiers as Captain they became Champions and promoted into London 2. The restructuring of the league system the title became National 3 London & South-East. Tom Coleman captained the Club to two Championship wins in 2012-13 pipping Dorking by one point and a memorable final match of the season against Old Elthamians and again in 2016-17. This time Old Elthamians get the runners up spot and promoted alongside Bishop's Stortford by winning their playoff.



THE NEW LAWS FOR 2017-18

The northern hemisphere will be catching up with the southern hemisphere from August 1st with the Global Law Trials. And then getting ahead with the new ruck/tackle and scrum laws.

Of the 17 trials, the following are the most relevant:

- The tackler has no special rights at the tackle anymore. After the tackle, they can only enter the tackle from their side of the tackle.
- A ruck commences when one player on their feet is over the ball on the ground at the tackle. They don't need to be in contact with an opposition player (sorry Italy!)
- Any player in the front row can strike for the ball. At least one player from the team who put the ball must strike for the ball. Free kick if not.

Other changes:

- Uncontested scrums must have 8 v 8, even if a team has less than 15 players.
- If you kick for touch from a penalty after the whistle to end the half, it is still possible to kick for touch and have a lineout. If you want to kick the ball dead to end the half, you simply tap kick and then kick to touch.
- Penalty tries are automatically worth seven points and there's no need for a kick for a conversion.
- A player cannot kick the ball out towards the opposition try line when it's in a ruck.
- There's no signal for the ball to come into the scrum. Once it's stable it must be put in.
- The scrum-half can stand with their outside shoulder on the middle line.
- The number 8 can pick up the ball from the feet of the second rows.
- Other laws are on clarifications on in-goal and in-touch.

THE OVAL CLUB WAS FOUNDED IN 1998 BY A GROUP OF MEMBERS WHO GOT TOGETHER TO FIND A WAY OF RAISING FUNDS FOR THE CLUB WHICH COULD BE USED TO FUND FACILITIES AND PROJECTS WHICH WOULD ENHANCE THE PLAYING SIDE OF THE CLUB. WITH THAT IN MIND THE STATED MISSION STATEMENT OF THE OVAL CLUB IS:

'TO CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS PROMOTING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE STANDARD OF RUGBY THROUGHOUT BISHOPS STORTFORD RUGBY CLUB'

The Oval Club operates as an autonomous body and is entirely independent of the Rugby Club's financial and administrative operations. No member of the Oval Club Committee can be a member of the official Rugby Club management. The Oval Club does not seek to influence decisions of the Rugby Club.

Of the contributions received into The Oval Club's Fund two thirds of each contribution is set aside for the Rugby Club and one third is allocated to the Members to fund social occasions.

Since its establishment the Oval Club has raised over £225,000 and to date £138,000 has been allocated in support of funding requests from the Rugby Club for many projects including:

- Floodlighting the back field pitches,
- Improvement of the playing surfaces, including the purchase of a Verti-

drainer,

- Supporting Youth and Mini through, tours, kit and additional playing facilities,
- Replacement of goal posts,
- Playing equipment and travel costs for all teams,
- Purchase of physiotherapy equipment,
- Refurbishing the changing rooms' showers,
- The drainage of the floodlit pitch,
- · Junior coaching courses, and
- Pitch repair and maintenance.

At present on the Member's side social functions held each year include:

A Home Match Lunch and Drinks An away match Coach Trip and Lunch and Drinks

An Annual Forum Dinner and Drinks incorporating a partially financed Golf day

The current membership is 74 which is deemed by the Committee as an appropriate and manageable number however this is not set in stone and new members are always welcome. If anyone would like to join please contact one of the Committee Members listed below.






