FROM CAPTAIN TO COACH: TOM COLEMAN

MAKING THE TRANSITION FROM
PLAYING TO COACHING IS SOMETHING I'VE BEEN
IN THE PROCESS OF DOING FOR A WHILE NOW,
THE ONLY DIFFERENCE THIS YEAR IS THAT THE
BOOTS ARE WELL AND TRULY HUNG UP!

Although it's probably fair to say I still find it incredibly difficult at times to watch the boys play, I still get plenty of kicks out of watching them put in great performances like our first two league games.

Working with such a talented and committed group of players makes are life a lot easier. but Lalso really enjoy working and learning from the other coaches, sharing ideas and challenging each other is one of the key foundations to our success.

Everyone involved in our squad wants to be a better player and coach, it's our job to come up with the answers to what makes people tick. Being challenged in any walk of life can put people on edge a little, but that's what we want from each other and certainly the players. If people get too comfortable then performances may drop and have a knock on effect to our results.

Our weekly planning is very meticulous, the boys absorb a lot of information on our opposition and we encourage them to communicate effectively during video sessions. This is something that transcends to the field and we challenge them to come up with the answers under pressure.

We are aware how difficult Plymouth will be to play against this weekend, certainly our toughest test at this level so far. With the underdog tag firmly at our feet for the first time in a while, I'm excited to see if the boys can rise to the challenge and put in another memorable performance at Silver Leys.

CARLY BUILDS BAND OF SCRUM SISTERS

AS THE FOUNDER OF LITTLE SCRUMMERS COACHING FOR CHILDREN, CARLY POYSER IS VERY MUCH INVOLVED IN THE WORLD OF RUGBY.

She's always enjoyed the sport having grown up around it as her brother played for Harlow. Today her company sponsors national rugby awards and she attends various award ceremonies. "I had been at a few of these events, watching as players picked up awards and it just made me think of what we were missing at Bishop's Stortford. I decided that I was going to approach the club about the possibility of starting up a ladies section. Although there had been an attempt to get a ladies section going at the club a few years ago it had just faded away." After a chat with chairman Colin Tilley, who pledged his backing. Carly moved quickly to set the wheels in motion. "I got in touch with Colin at the beginning of October last year and he was great, really willing to help, it was good timing too as women's rugby was - and is very topical. I then contacted the RFU< who were also all for it" Carly produced some flyers and organised advertising to raise awareness and on the first night of training, on November 1 last year, 24 ladies turned up.

The first training session took the form of a 'pitch up and play' event and RFU's Tom Mowbray, Mel Liley and Clare Mowbray came along so the evening started with a real buzz. "said Carly. "After that I wasn't going to hang about, I thought let's not build up slowly and surely, let's just go for it! Two of my good friends came along on that first night and since then we have encouraged ladies to try and bring friends along to get the numbers up. We also did a carnival float this year to help raise the profile.

Carly is passionate about her mission to establish a successful ladies section and is delighted at how rapidly it is growing. She has longer-term plans to make the transition from different age groups more seamless for the girls and young women who want to continue with the sport. "I know with the girls at Little Scrummers that when they reach an age where they can't do it any more they often want to continue with the friends they've made in their age group. We want to inspire them to carry on. There's just something about rugby. It offers something for everyone, whether you're tall short, fat or think. There's too much criticism from women towards other women, comments about what they look like etc but it's different with rugby.

There's a rapport and a camaraderie that is great. Women support each other and it's inspiring" The ladies team is open to players over 17 of all abilities and fitness standards. Weekly training sessions are held each Tuesday from 7 – 9pm at BSRFC

TODAY'S OPPOSITION PLYMOUTH ALBION RFC





THE PRESENT CLUB WAS FOUNDED IN 1920 FROM A MFRGER BETWEEN PLYMOUTH REC AND DEVONPORT ALBION RFC (BOTH FOUNDED IN 1876). SINCE 2003 THEY HAVE PLAYED THEIR HOME GAMES AT THE BRICKFIELDS STADIUM

After thirteen seasons in the Championship, in 2015 they were relegated to National One.

Albion were a major force in English rugby union in the 1920s having five internationals on their books at one time. Around this time they attracted a crowd of 18,000 to a midweek game against Oxford University which established a record crowd for a club match in England which was not exceeded until the 1980s.

On their way to promotion to Nat One in 2002, the team went on a two season unbeaten streak of over 50 games, starting when the club was in Division Three South.

Albion have experienced financial problems of late and only avoided entering administration early in 2015 following a cash injection of £250,000 by local businesses. That though did not save them from formally entering administration in April 2016 at which point two former players, Bruce Priday and David Venables came to their rescue. However by going into administration they incurred a RFU penalty of a 30 point deduction.

This resulted in them finishing 5th last season instead of clear Runners up to Hartpury. They are therefore one of the favourites for promotion this season.

Today is the first time they will have visited Silver Levs, although it's familiar territory for one of their recently ex-players Back rower Rupert Cooper, who left Albion in May for the Cornish Pirates, as he played for our winning National Colts Cup team of 2006 & 1st XV with Tom. Marcus. The Warrior & Gilly!



THE NEW LAWS FOR 2017-18

The northern hemisphere will be catching up with the southern hemisphere from August 1st with the Global Law Trials. And then getting ahead with the new ruck/tackle and scrum laws.

Of the 17 trials, the following are the most relevant:

- The tackler has no special rights at the tackle anymore. After the tackle, they can only enter the tackle from their side of the tackle.
- A ruck commences when one player on their feet is over the ball on the ground at the tackle. They don't need to be in contact with an opposition player (sorry Italy!)
- Any player in the front row can strike for the ball. At least one player from the team who put the ball must strike for the ball.
 Free kick if not.

Other changes:

- Uncontested scrums must have 8 v 8, even if a team has less than 15 players.
- If you kick for touch from a penalty after the whistle to end the half, it is still possible to kick for touch and have a lineout. If you want to kick the ball dead to end the half, you simply tap kick and then kick to touch.
- Penalty tries are automatically worth seven points and there's no need for a kick for a conversion.
- A player cannot kick the ball out towards the opposition try line when it's in a ruck.
- There's no signal for the ball to come into the scrum. Once it's stable it must be put in.
- The scrum-half can stand with their outside shoulder on the middle line.
- The number 8 can pick up the ball from the feet of the second rows.
- Other laws are on clarifications on in-goal and in-touch.



IN THE SPOTLIGHT: JIMMY REA

MENTION BISHOP'S STORTFORD RUGBY TO ANY FAN AND THEY WILL RECOGNISE THE NAME JIMMY REA.

Jimmy has been a familiar fixture at the Club since he was a young boy and as he enters his tenth year playing for the First Team, shows no sign of slowing up.

One of Jimmy's earliest memories was messing around in the garden with his father, who was no stranger to the sport himself, having played for Saffron Walden, Bishop's Stortford and Upper Clapton. "I always remember him telling me to go for the gap" Jimmy recalls, "although it was once I went to school and that I really got involved"

Under school coach Sandy Barnard he played for the Under 11s as well as the Junior School First Team. He was also encouraged to join the mini rugby at BSRFC with his friend Tom Coleman.

"When I went up to the senior school I was playing in the Under 15s B team. We were fortunate at the time to go on seven tours in less than seven years, which was great experience."

It was on one of these tours to South Africa, when Jimmy got his first big break. "I was always the last one standing, the 16th man but then fate intervened when one player broke his shoulder and I stepped up." After that Jimmy had a trial for England at just 17 and at the same age was selected to play for Hertfordshire's Under 20s squad. He was also part of the winning team playing for the Colts when they won the National Colts Plate in 2011. "We were only in the plate competition because we just lost against Harlequins." he added.

Over the past 20 years Bishop's Stortford rugby club has been a constant in Jimmy's life. Even when he went off to university, where he also played, he made sure he was back for pre-season matches.

"I couldn't imagine my life without it to be honest," he admits. "Last year was probably the hardest year of my life, when my three year old daughter was undergoing tests. We were told she had cerebral palsy but she had to go through literally hundreds of tests. She is clinically disabled and it was a hard time but the club gave me an outlet. The coaches, staff, in fact everyone up there just got it and I had the freedom to focus on something else. I've been incredibly fortunate and even now, at the edge of retirement, I am thinking what can I do to give back. The club has been so significant to me that I just can't think of not being involved. My passion is bringing the youth on and I really enjoy seeing the youngsters who could take my place improving. If they can benefit from my experience now then that's great."

With his two young daughters and a third due in eight weeks time, a full time 'day job as an organic arable farmer with a beef herd, will Jimmy be thinking of hanging up his boots any time soon to spend more time with his young family?

"My wife is the only reason I'm still playing rugby! I had contemplated retiring but she persuaded me to continue. I thought about going out on a high after last season's promotion but she said I would kick myself if I didn't play."

Jimmy has plenty of family support. His wife watches most of his home games, as do his mum and dad as well as lots of the away games too. "There's a photo of me and my dad after the final game at Bishop's Stortford and we are both in bits. That about sums up the club really. It is so family focussed and a huge part of my life."
