WELCOME BACK TO SILVER LEYS FOR TODAY'S NATIONAL ONE ENCOUNTER WITH HULL IONIANS RFC.

This will be the first time we will have played each other so I'd like to extend a particularly warm welcome to all their Players, Officials and any Supporters who have made the long trip south from the Humber.

Last time out here we came up against a proficient and battle hardened Ampthill side and came off second best. We were far from disgraced in losing 22-41 but if truth be told they thoroughly deserved their victory.

Today's opponents Hull Ionians are another new challenge for us. They have had a difficult start to this season, losing their first five games. However rather ominously they hit form last weekend at home, when they scored no fewer than six tries to defeat Esher 43-28.

Last weekend for the first time this season we managed to field all of our five senior men's teams. Aside from the 1's, our Blues drew 12 all with a Coventry Development XV, our Mitres or 3rd XV beat Hammersmith & Fulham 39-7, our Chindits lost out on the road to their counterparts at Ampthill but our Abbots beat Southgate 15-10

A VERY WARM WELCOME TO HULL IONIANS ON THEIR FIRST EVER VISIT TO SILVER LEYS, WHO COME TO US IN NEED OF SOME POINTS

after what must be, from their perspective, a disappointing start to the season. So, we will need to be on our metal this afternoon if we want to come away with the win.

I was not able to get to the game against Coventry last week and, on seeing the close result, which gave us a losing bonus point, thought we had done very well. On talking to those who did go, we could just as easily have come away with four points if the rub of the green had gone our way!

It is becoming increasingly apparent that we can more than hold our own in this League and the players have certainly risen to the challenge in a big way. We currently sit in seventh place in the League, with fifteen points and a won three, lost three record, which any of us would have taken at the beginning of the season, especially as we have already played three of the sides sides in the top five, including Coventry and Plymouth in first and second places currently, and given a good account of ourselves. Other sides in the League are certainly beginning to find out where Bishop's Stortford is!

I had the pleasure of spending much of last Sunday at the Club watching a full programme of activity that really reflected the range of activity we have going on across all age groups.

In the morning, Mini training was followed by

a number of Youth matches, which we won playing a good standard of rugby that bodes well for the future. In the afternoon, we hosted the first Ladies league home game of the season on Pitch 3, while on Pitch 4 we hosted a Touch Rugby Festival in support of the President's charity, the Essex and Herts Air Ambulance. Very well done to the Touch group, who raised a magnificent £553 from the event.

A special mention also to the Ladies, who were extremely nervous about playing their first League fixture at home in front of a good crowd of supporters, both from Stortford and their opponents, Royston. This showed in the first quarter when Royston scored two tries and then were awarded a penalty try just before half time, which gave them a 19-0 lead. A superb turnaround by Stortford in the second half based upon a determined team spirit, some good back play and superior fitness resulted in a close 26-24 victory, which leaves them unbeaten in their first two games.

Finally, a warm welcome back to Paul Maxfield following his release from hospital and who has already retaken his chair at the bar, and resumed his association with his favourite red wine!



TODAY'S OPPOSITION

HULL IONIANS RFC



HULL IONIANS WERE FORMED IN 1989 WHEN HULL AND EAST RIDING MERGED WITH IONIANS

At the time Hull and East Riding only had a small 1st XV squad & were without ownership of their own ground or clubhouse. Conversely Ionians owned their ground and clubhouse had a thriving mini/junior section that was developing many excellent young players, but a first team that required more experience in order to retain them. The merger was therefore a perfect arrangement and proved to be just that immediately.

In1994 they moved a short distance from the Ionians ground to their current location at Brantingham Park which is situated in the village of Brantingham, which is 12 miles to the west of the city of Hull.

In 2012/13 they won National 2 North and gained promotion to National 1. In doing so they became the first East Yorkshire club to play at Level 3.

Unfortunately National 1 proved a big step for the club and they only managed to secure 3 victories in the 2013/14 season meaning an immediate return to Level but in 2014/15 the club once again won National 2 North to regain their

place in National 1.

In 2015 /16 they finished 12th winning 9 but losing 21 of their games. Last season they finished 13th winning 10 games, drawing one & losing 19.

They lost their first five games of this season but won last weekend at home to Esher 43-28

They have four senior men's teams and thriving Mini & Youth sections



COVENTRY 30 BISHOP'S STORTFORD 1ST XV 27

A fantastic, battling performance by Bishop's Stortford produces a well-deserved losing bonus point and, but for a couple of frustrating late penalty calls might even have brought a remarkable win. As it was, the mighty Coventry team were pleased to hear the final whistle. The win being sufficient to take them to the top of the table.

The visitors opened the scoring when a clever short lineout between Dec Caulfield and Dan Leo, saw the hooker in space. Quick support came from George Cullen who in turn offloaded out of the back door to set winger. Chris Smith clear to the line after three minutes. Cullen converted from the touchline. Coventry were straight onto the front foot from the restart and a missed tackle on ex All Black, Tuitupou was coolly closed out with an unconverted try out wide to the right wing on 6 minutes. Play now swung back Stortford's way and Cullen stretched the lead 6 minutes later to 5 with a penalty from in front of the posts after a breakdown infringement. Four minutes later, Coventry were awarded their own penalty in front of the opposition posts. This time, though, they opted to go for touch and the wisdom of this decision was borne out with a try shortly after to Tuitupou, after the initial driving maul from the lineout had been stopped. It was Coventry fly half, Maisey's turn to convert from the touchline to take his side into a 2 point lead. Within 3 minutes, though, the visitors had their noses in front from another Cullen penalty. The match continued to seesaw and a badly missed tackle by Stortford in midfield saw the home side onto the attack, with the opening being exploited to the full through a converted try to Coventry's left wing after 23 minutes. The deficit was narrowed to 3 points some 10 minutes later with another Cullen penalty, which, almost inevitably, prefaced a period of Coventry attacking play. This culminated in a series of scrums and driving mauls in Stortford's 5 metre area and it took some fantastic defence by Stortford to see out the half with the score at 19-16.

The first score of the second period came after a poor defensive kick by Coventry gave the visitors another attacking platform and this time no mistake was made. Some great handling by forwards and backs, switching left then right, created an opportunity for James Lennon to spin out a pinpoint long pass and create a huge gap for Rory Banks to stride through for a try. Cullen's conversion attempt went just wide, leaving his side 2 points ahead after 52 minutes. There followed an extensive period of Coventry pressure, which met with some more tremendous Stortford defence, albeit at the cost of a yellow card to Dec Caulfield for an offence at a driving maul in his own 22. The pressure being felt by the home side was clearly demonstrated, though a couple of minutes later, when they settled for another 3 points from Maisey's boot, following a further penalty in front of the posts after 22 minutes. Yet, within 3 minutes, another Cullen penalty had turned the one point deficit into a 2 point lead. As the game continued to swing to and fro, a potentially decisive score came after 5 minutes, when powerful Coventry fullback, James Stokes crashed through Stortford's defensive line and dummied his way past two covering defenders for an unconverted try.

Undaunted, Stortford were straight back on the attack, forcing another penalty, which Cullen converted to level the scores with some 7 minutes to play. With the Coventry crowd now baying their support, the home side threw themselves back onto the attack, but more dogged defence from Stortford kept their line intact, despite wave after wave of forward pressure. Eventually, though a penalty was awarded to Coventry at a scrum under the posts and Maisey made no mistake. Stortford again threatened to take the lead, with some impressive running and handling, but were thwarted as a couple of penalty decisions went against them at breakdowns and the home side was able to hold on for a narrow win – a huge compliment to Stortford, that such illustrious opponents were ready to settle for such a narrow home win




more of a regular in the team and have gone on to play over 100 games across three leagues for the blue and white's.

BSRFC Ladies are now 2 games into their season and sitting at the top of the League table. A win away against St. Neots in our first match gave the Ladies a much needed confidence boost. They returned home last Sunday to play at Silver Leys after a 3 week rest and with the support of a large home crowd, the team set the bar high to secure their second win against Royston, which could prove to be our hardest opponent this season. The women are looking forward to impressing coaches and supporters alike throughout the season.
