IN THE SPOTLIGHT: RORY & TOM BANKS

AS EARLY AS I CAN REMEMBER BSRFC HAS BEEN A MASSIVE PART OF MY LIFE AS WELL AS FOR THE REST OF MY FAMILY'S.

Being more vertically challenged than my 2 older brothers means I have always tried to prove myself physically, which is probably why I have grown into a scrum half who enjoys a ruck or two. Training for the physical aspect of rugby started with games of Trampoline Rugby between the 3 of us, which usually ended in some form of tears (for Ollie).

I have always been very self-critical of my performances and set myself a high standard which probably stems from the competitive environment we were coached under in the minis and youth teams. I have vivid memories of JC and Nigel Smith getting down to us at eye level during huddles before matches at several tournaments, with empowering and almost deranged stares, demanding us to 'get angry'. It worked as we went 5 years without losing and 3 years without conceding a try which culminated in winning a National U12's trophy at Twickenham.

I have played alongside a majority of this group through the club, at school and University. The majority with my brother Rory for which we have shared a lot of rugby successes. It was an honour to become National 2 South champions with such a close group of friends and being able to represent England Students and Counties alongside some of them has been a personal highlight for me.

Tom

My first experience of rugby might have put me off the sport altogether had it not been for the enthusiastic coaching from Andy Mumford and John Lewis whose sessions were always fun and enjoyable. I remember on a cold November morning in 1998 being dragged up to Hertford Rugby club for my very first minis tournament at 6 years old, rain hitting me like sharp pins, my extremities numb and my teeth chattering uncontrollably after playing only 2 minutes of the tournament, I don't think I enjoyed it much! From this memory I learnt being in the pack might be the best place for me, amongst the warmth of the scrum.

I started my rugby life off as a hooker (with Declan Caulfield as full back, how things change!) However, England Women's International Hannah Gallagher's departure from the boys game at U13's necessitated a team reshuffle. I developed my passing technique and became the team's first male scrum half.

At the age of 15 I was picked to play for TBSHS 1st XV and the former BSRFC 1st XV coach, Ian Simpson, saw my bullish character, playing hooker, together with the skills I learnt playing trampoline rugby with my brothers and the link play I had developed from my short stint in the backs, I was moulded into an openside flanker. Despite having played nearly every position in my career the back row is always the one I've found the most enjoyable.

My career highlights would include; reaching the quarter final of the Daily Mail Cup where my hit on Elliot Daly lead to our only score of the game by Aran Martinson in a 58-5 loss to Whitgift School (Marland Yarde scored 5 tries!!). I was playing in the centre alongside BSRFC Matchday Experience Coach Ash Boyle. Also beating Hertford at Allianz Park with the Blues and of course getting my first taste of Nat 1 rugby this year.



TODAY'S OPPOSITION ESHER RFC



THE CLUB WAS FORMED IN 1923 WHEN FOUR RUGBY ENTHUSIASTS MET IN A PUB AND DECIDED TO FORM A RUGBY CLUB.

One of them, a Welshman insisted that the new club should adopt his native Welsh club's colours. Which is why Esher play in the same Black and Amber as Newport to this day.

At the outbreak of the Second World War, Esher had moved to its present site in Molesey Rd and were fielding eight sides, but war disrupted activities and the pitches were ploughed up for food production. Post war amazingly they ran as many as fifteen sides each Saturday!

Esher were first promoted to National League 2 South in 1998. In 2007 they were promoted to National One and again just three years later to the Championship in a season that famously saw them set a new world record in beating Manchester 148 – 0.

They played in the Championship for two seasons before being relegated back into National League 1 for the 2012–13 season.

In 2013 they finished Runners up; in 2014 – 5th ; 2015- 10th; 2016 -7th & last Season 8th. This is the first occasion upon which we have met at 1st Xv level.



BLACKHEATH RFC 19 BISHOP'S STORTFORD 1ST XV 21

Playing with the breeze and slope, Blackheath dominated most of the first period with hard, aggressive rugby and some clinical finishing. Stortford defended well for 10 minutes, a couple of penalties then took them deep into Stortford's half. Good lineout ball was spun quickly wide and, unusually, the visitors' defence was found wanting. Blackheath's left wing ruthlessly exploited the resultant overlap and flyhalf, Joe Tarrant added an excellent touchline conversion.

Stortford were struggling to get a toehold in the game, with Blackheath's aggressive line speed and tackling forcing turnovers on the few occasions that the visitors managed to gain possession. After 18 minutes the home side added an unconverted try to their tally after some good tactical kicking. A rather lacklustre Stortford chase of a returned kick made the home side's job a little easier but they once again showed their ability to close out chances. When flanker, Harry Bate scored a third try with 37 minutes played and Tarrant's conversion took the lead out to 19 points, Stortford, who had yet to mount any sort of concerted attack looked almost out for the count. In typically gritty fashion, though they ended the half with a period of sustained possession, slowly working their way up the field and winning a penalty at a breakdown. George Cullen kicked to touch and the pack finished things off, driving the resultant maul over the Blackheath line for a try to Will Roberts. Cullen completed the half with a great conversion from out wide to send his side into the break only 12 points behind - a pretty satisfactory situation on the balance of play.

The second half was a mirror-image of the first, with Stortford dominating possession and territory and the home side this time being called upon to show determination in defence. Blackheath did manage to mount one powerful early attack and would have scored a probably decisive 4th try, had their outside backs not got in a muddle out wide, being penalised for crossing with the Stortford try line wide open.

That proved to be the last time that the home side was seen as an attacking force, as Stortford started to go through the gears, showing some typically remorseless 15-man rugby. This finally stretched the home defence to breaking point, with debutant fullback, Rob Duff combining with Chris Smith to put the winger clear for a try well scored round behind the posts after 50 minutes. Cullen's conversion narrowed the deficit to 5 points and his side spent much of the remaining half an hour hammering at the Blackheath line, but repeatedly foundering on some tremendously committed defending.

Stortford stuck to their guns, though and eventually, showing more patience than on a couple of earlier occasions, forced an overlap. This was thwarted only by a blatant deliberate knock-on and although the guilty fullback was sin-binned, a penalty try was not awarded, the officials spotting a covering player who in their view might have prevented a try. With only a couple of minutes to go, this might have been decisive but, undeterred, Stortford launched another series of sharp attacks from the resultant penalty to touch. Finally they moved the ball wide, where Duff took full advantage of the missing defender to outpace his opposite number with a diagonal dash to the line. This leveled the scores and, with time virtually up, Cullen showed great nerve to bang a tricky conversion between the posts for a remarkable Stortford win.

'TO CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS PROMOTING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE STANDARD OF RUGBY THROUGHOUT BISHOP'S STORTFORD RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB'

The Oval Club is an autonomous body and entirely independent of the Rugby Club's operations. None of the Committee members hold a position or appointment in the Rugby Club's infrastructure. The Oval Club does not seek to influence decisions of the Rugby Club. It responds to requests for financial assistance for projects and purposes which have been approved by the Rugby Club's Executive Committee and which fall within its mission statement above.

Of the funds raised two thirds is set aside for the Rugby Club the other third is reserved to fund social events for Members.

To date the Oval Club has raised over £225,000 and the Rugby Club has received in excess of £138,000.

In line with its mission statement The Oval Club makes contributions for one off projects and purposes which are of long term value to the Rugby Club and not part of on-going budget requirements. 




