NEWS FROM THE BLUES LUKE WEBBER - THE INTERVIEW

AFTER 3 STRAIGHT WINS AND THE TEAM PERFORMING STRONGLY, WHY DO YOU THINK WE COULDN'T QUITE GET OVER THE LINE AGAINST RICHMOND LAST WEEKEND?

After a slow start to the season we've managed to regain a lot of confidence with good wins against Jersey, Blackheath and Esher. But Richmond Vikings are a different animal. The game itself showed that we are capable of competing with the top sides, but we just lacked that composure in the key attacking areas of the field and were let down by our discipline in defensive areas. A team like Richmond won't let you get away with that.

The Blues have now given two colts their first taste of senior rugby this year. Out of the younger members in the squad who have been some key contributors so far?

Young lads like Ollie Jones & James Apperley are just two examples of colts players who have earnt their stripes in the Blues before establishing themselves as important components of the 1st XV. But the Blues can still boast the likes of Ben Harrison, Zac Jeffery and Joe Tracy who have become essential members of the squad having graduated from the Colts in recent years. More recently we've introduced Austin Pope to senior rugby and he's been excellent for us so far. The future's bright.

You are now in your 6th season as a Blues player, how have you seen the 2nd XV develop over this period?

I was first brought into the 2nd team setup when Steve Hearn was tasked with the job of rejuvenating the Blues. At the time, I was playing social rugby in the 5th team against 50-year-old vets! Our first season we won the league in a playoff final away at Thurrock and it felt we were setting an example as a second team. Then came the Zoo League setup, and the Blues began growing in quality and reputation. Over the past 3 or 4 seasons not only have we become a brilliant platform for players to realise their 1st XV aspirations, but the Blues is a team that everyone wants to be a part of in its own right. It can't be underestimated the impact this has on the success of the 1st team.

With us nearly at the Christmas break, what is the target for the Blues at the break and come the end of the season?

Having found our rhythm with more consistent team selections and a good run of results, we are beginning to see where we fit in to this new look Zoo Division 1. With the likes of Richmond, London Scottish, Old Elthamians and Ampthill realising the benefit of second team rugby, we cannot realistically expect to reach the heights of 2nd spot as we did last term. However, we know we can compete with anyone on our day, so we are just looking to take each game as it comes, get better each time we take to the field and see where it leaves us come April. I fancy top 6 and third county cup on the bounce would be another season we could be very happy with.

On a slightly different note. Many of you will already be very aware of the testing times ahead for Samoan rugby players after their RFU announced bankruptcy recently. The Blues played their very small part in supporting Samoan rugby at training last week by holding up the #helpsamoa . Dan Leo has set up a justgiving page to help support the players and their families and it would be great if you could donate!!



TODAY'S OPPOSITIONDARLINGTON MOWDEN PARK REC



TODAY'S OPPONENTS BEGAN LIFE IN 1950 WHEN THEY WERE FOUNDED AS DARI INGTON GRAMMAR SCHOOL OLD BOYS.

With growing numbers of players and supporters, they decided to buy land and build their own clubhouse and pitches in Mowden. It therefore seemed appropriate, not least because the club was no longer an "Old Boys Club", to change its name to Mowden Park RFC.

In more recent years they were given permission to restore the 'Darlington' They were promoted to National One at the end of the 2013–14 season when they beat Ampthill in the promotion playoff.

In December 2012 Darlington Mowden Park RFC purchased what was then known as the Darlington arena, a 25,000 seat stadium that had previously been the home of Darlington F.C. along with 17 acres of adjacent land and an option on a further 20 acres for a reported £2 million. They played their first game at what is now known as the Northern Echo Arena in February 2013.

In 2014-15 they finished 9th in National One. In 15-16 they finished 6th & last season 10th.

This season therefore they are on course for their best ever placing as they currently sit second having won 8 of the 13 games played to date. Famous names to have worn the DMP shirt include Toby Flood, Alex Tait, Craig Newby, Phil Dowson & Tim Visser.

They have three Senior Men's XV's and Darlington Mowden Park Sharks play in the Tyrrells Premier 15's, the Women's Premiership. In additional they have two further senior women's teams & a successful Mini & Youth section including Girls rugby



Esher seemed to take time to adjust to the Hertfordshire climate and were slow out of the blocks, allowing Stortford to dominate the opening exchanges of this game, sponsored by active Club supporters, GQ Wealth Management. The resultant pressure culminated in a try to Matt Riddington, who dodged and powered his way over the line from some 25 yards out, after fellow centre, Sam Winter had made a telling break and good ground. George Cullen's confident conversion took his side out to a 7 point lead and it was the same player who added three points to the tally with a penalty goal some 20 minutes later.

In the meantime, an aggressive Esher side had steadily become more of a force, aided somewhat, it has to be said by some loose Stortford kicking. As a result, the visitors enjoyed much more possession, but were rebuffed repeatedly by a strong Stortford defence, which, with Sam Winter leading by example, never seemed to lose its shape, despite being stretched on occasions by some powerful running and some clever long passes. Despite the pressure, Stortford managed a rare sortie into Esher's 22 after some 25 minutes, forcing a penalty at a breakdown and Cullen kicked the goal to stretch the lead to 10. The home side then enjoyed a period of possession and were threatening on the Esher 22, when an ambitious chip kick under pressure was smothered and the visitors were quick to capitalise on the resultant turnover. They drove upfield and some impressive handling amongst their backs in the Stortford 22 produced an impressive try close to the posts giving flyhalf, Paul Roberts an easy conversion just before the break to take his side into the distant changing rooms only 3 points adrift.

With the game so evenly poised, both sides came out aggressively but, despite a few errors and, in particular a couple of soft penalty concessions, it was Stortford that enjoyed the better of the early exchanges. Thus it was that 15 minutes into the half, the home side won a penalty and kicked for touch around halfway, which they used as the platform to launch a tremendous attack, based on quick handling and repeated recycling. This took them to the within the shadow of the Esher posts and a strong ruck produced quick ball, which Tom Banks seized on to dive over the line, giving Cullen an easy conversion. Better was to come within 5 minutes, when another spell of running rugby and quick recycling allowed replacement winger, Ryan Hutler to run in under the posts from a well-timed, short pass. Cullen's conversion took the score to 24-7 and the home side now looked to be getting on top after the restart.

Two penalties in quick succession against Stortford, though - the first won by Esher's powerful pack at a scrum and the second at the resultant lineout - gave the visitors a lineout on Stortford's 5 metre line. An efficient catch and drive duly produced a try out wide, but Roberts' conversion attempt fell just short. Esher clearly took renewed confidence from this score and quickly exerted more pressure on Stortford's defence. Another penalty to the visitors with about 5 minutes to go again went to touch for a 5 metre lineout and, once again, Stortford were unable to hold out a powerful drive from the Esher pack. Roberts again, just missed the conversion, leaving his side 7 points behind. This was enough to secure a losing bonus point for the visitors, but neither side was content to settle for what they had, with both going hammer and tongs at the opposition in search of a fourth try. In the event, strong defences won the day and the game ended with the 24-17 scoreline.

There were many outstanding performances on both sides in this closely-contested match, but the Man of the Match sponsors, Copper 88 chose Stortford flyhalf, George Cullen for the award. Congratulations go to all 20 of Stortford's players for another battling display, which should allow them to enjoy their break next weekend that bit more - though the challenge thereafter posed by the visit of Darlington Mowden Park will certainly not be lost sight of!!



'TO CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS PROMOTING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE STANDARD OF RUGBY THROUGHOUT BISHOP'S STORTFORD RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB'

The Oval Club is an autonomous body and entirely independent of the Rugby Club's operations. None of the Committee members hold a position or appointment in the Rugby Club's infrastructure. The Oval Club does not seek to influence decisions of the Rugby Club. It responds to requests for financial assistance for projects and purposes which have been approved by the Rugby Club's Executive Committee and which fall within its mission statement above.

Of the funds raised two thirds is set aside for the Rugby Club the other third is reserved to fund social events for Members.

To date the Oval Club has raised over £225,000 and the Rugby Club has received in excess of £138.000.

In line with its mission statement The Oval Club makes contributions for one off projects and purposes which are of long term value to the Rugby Club and not part of on-going budget requirements. Invariably contributions have been made to the Club to enable them to secure grants from the RFU and other sources.

So far, major contributions have been made towards the cost of :

- Pitch repair and maintenance,
- Improvement of the playing surfaces, including the purchase of a verti-drainer,
- Floodlighting the back field pitches,
- Drainage of the floodlit pitches,

- Replacement of goal posts,
- Playing equipment and travel costs for all teams.
- Purchase of physiotherapy equipment,
- Refurbishing the changing room showers.
- Supporting youth and mini through tours, kit and additional playing facilities,
- Junior coaching courses.

On the social side there are several Members' events which take place throughout each year for. Currently these are:

- A First Team Away coach trip and lunch






