PRESIDENT'S WELCOME PERRY OLIVER

I think it's fair to say that as we've moved into 2018 we've lost a bit of momentum and not just at 1st XV level!

I think we always anticipated that the second half of the season would be tougher than the first that only goes so far in explaining our hiccup in form. Others may disagree but I don't think we can have too many complaints about our losses to Rosslyn Park & Ampthill. In both games we were second best for long periods, struggling to secure & then retain possession of the ball for any sustained passage of time. On a positive note when we did we invariably scored but by then we were playing catch up.

So it is against that backdrop that this afternoon we're visited by the runaway leaders of the division. Our opponents today have only failed to win one game all season, an aberration a couple of weeks back against Blackheath, and despite that are still the red hot favourites to secure the one promotion place available into the Championship. You'd therefore have to be an eternal optimist to predict a home win this afternoon.

Or would you? Our guys often perform at their best when written off. You only have to look at the game at Coventry back in the first week of October to see that. We supporters travelled more in hope than expectation but that clearly wasn't the case for the players. That afternoon they produced a determined & resilient display against an excellent Coventry team and but for a couple of unfortunate 'bounces of the ball' may well have emerged with an unlikely but nonetheless deserved victory. If they can produce a similar display this afternoon anything could happen.

Results haven't been much better elsewhere in our senior rugby section. Injuries in the First XV have undoubtedly impacted on our Blues. They consistently show considerable spirit & great fight but are often outmuscled. They must be very frustrated because they seem to have lost so many games by just a single score. Our Mitres are struggling to get any game time. Far too many of their scheduled match ups fail to materialise and it's a worry.

Once again at the time of writing we have six senior games this weekend but if recent experience is anything to go by it'll be a miracle if they all get played; Our Blues and Chindits are here against Coventry Development & Ampthill respectively, whilst our Mitres and Abbotts are on the road at Hammersmith & Fulham and Southgate. Our Ladies will also be looking to get back to winning ways when they entertain Welwyn tomorrow afternoon.

Finally I think with all the rain we've had of late I can safely predict that it's going to be a bit soft underfoot this afternoon and would recommend that unless you're wearing wellies you use the concrete path that runs behind the tree line to reach pitch side.

Here's hoping its better rugby watching weather this weekend than it was last. But as always I hope you enjoy your afternoon with us here at Stortford.

BOB "THE SHOP"10 YEARS ON

MY FIRST ASSOCIATION WITH THE CLUB BEGAN WHEN MY SON JOINED THE UNDER 7s IN 1999.

In common with many current and past Mini and Youth parents, my wife, Julie, and I spent many wet, windy and freezing Sunday mornings cheering on our kids with endless enthusiasm!

With high calibre coaches such as John Cullen and Jim Taylor at our disposal, I realised I was best deployed supporting the age group as a Team Manager and took up the role from the Under 13s to Colts. We had a talented and committed group realising their potential by winning the Colts National Plate at the "Mecca of English Rugby", Franklins Gardens, in 2011. With a team including Tom Banks, George Cullen, Rory Young, Will Roberts, Tom McCrone, Jamie Campbell and Jack Scantlebury, the quality was there for all to see!

Ten years ago, I left my career in banking and was looking for new challenges. I found a new "day job" in Customer Service and an opportunity also arose to become involved at the Club on the commercial side and I took over the running of the club shop. My first action was to meet with the club's long standing kit suppliers and their unwillingness to offer credit terms or amend product supply rules resulted in me terminating the contract with immediate effect. Great start; no experience in running a club shop and no supplier in week one! Things could only get better!

I also had the pleasure of operating from a converted container at the back of the clubhouse which was dark and cold throughout the year! With help from Kerry, Denise, Janet, Karen and Elaine in those early years, we gradually started to get things moving. I found a new supplier and we tripled the turnover and doubled the profit in the first year. We then consolidated in the aftermath of the financial crisis and developed increasing sales which took a positive boost when we moved to the shop's current location at the front of the clubhouse some four years ago.

Since this time, the shop has become far more integrated within the club. Saturday sales in particular have risen markedly on the back of the considerable success of the 1st XV over this period. So much so that the total sales at this point of the season have exceeded the annual takings of all previous seasons over the past nine years! A big thank you to all our members and customers who have supported the club over the years and during this season in particular. I am passionate about providing the best service I can and I am constantly looking at ways of improving what we do with plans underway to improve our online offering.



TODAY'S OPPOSITION

COVENTRY RFC



COVENTRY CAN TRACE THEIR ORIGINS BACK TO 1874 WHEN THE FIRST ORGANISED GAME OF RUGBY FOOTBALL -IT TOOK THE FORM OF ONE HALF PLAYED ACCORDING TO RUGBY RULES AND THE OTHER ACCORDING TO ASSOCIATION RULES - WAS PLAYED IN THE CITY.

Their first ever ground was known as 'The Butts' but in 1921 they relocated to Coundon Road where they stayed until 2004.

The club was successful from the outset and indeed William Judkins became their first British Lion in 1899 during the tour to Australia. In the early 1970s at one time thirteen players from the club were representing England & not unsurprisingly they won The John Player Cup in consecutive seasons 1972–73 and 1973–74.

When league rugby was first introduced in 1987 the club was positioned in what is now known as the Premiership although they only survived one year at that level. In 1997 they came within touching distance of promotion back to the top level but they were soon to hit financial difficulties with a rescue package put together just in time for them to compete in the 1999–2000 season.

After eighty-four years the decision was made to move away from Coundon Road and return to the site of their original ground which is now known as The Butts Park Arena. Financial insecurity still dogged them though and two further 'rescues' were required in 2008 & 2009. Not unsurprisingly relegation from the Championship soon followed.

After a couple of seasons of consolidation at level three they have since become ever

presents at the business end of the table and it is therefore no surprise that this season they are carrying all before them as long time league leaders, as they look to regain their place in the Championship.

They can claim no fewer than 10 B&I Lions in total and famous rugby names to have worn their colours include Fran Cotton, David Duckham, Richard Cockerill, Danny Grewcock and of course their current President Peter Rossborough.

At the beginning of October we visited the Butts Park Arena for the first time and performed admirably despite losing to a late penalty 30-27



BISHOP'S STORTFORD 1ST XV 12 AMPTHILL AND DISTRICT 22

ERROR-PRONE STORTFORD WELL BEATEN BY A LIMITED BUT REMORSELESS AMPTHILL SIDE, REVELLING IN THE DANK CONDITIONS.

In a first half littered with errors, poor tactical kicking, soft penalty concessions and a faltering lineout, Stortford struggled to string any periods of possession together and did well to turn round only 10 points in arrears, thanks to some strong and determined defending.

The home side, by contrast were a model of control and consistency, being content to run through phase after phase before even thinking of going wide. It was just such a passage of play that led to the first try after 12 minutes, building from one of several 5 metre lineouts from penalties conceded far too readily by the visitors. Several thrusts from Ampthill's powerful forwards were rebuffed, but they showed good patience, sucking in Stortford's defence before finally and very clinically spinning the ball wide for their left wing to touch down out wide. James Pritchard kicked an excellent conversion from the touchline. Despite dominating possession and territory for the rest of the half, though, all the home side had to show for it was a penalty goal to Pritchard after 35 minutes for what appeared to be a harsh call of a high tackle.

Stortford finally found a bit of rhythm early in the second half, managing to string together a series of driving plays by the pack to give the backs some rare space. Matt Riddington was quick to seize on this, making a strong outside break and then finding Ryan Hutler cutting inside with a pinpoint offload, allowing the winger to plunge in for an unconverted try close to the touchline.

Ampthill then resumed control, but were held out again by some excellent Stortford defence, until an easy turnover, as Stortford broke from the back of a scrum in their own half caught them off balance and a testing crossfield kick from flyhalf, Lawrence Rayner was not dealt with at all, allowing the home left winger, to run in his second try. Another great conversion stretched the lead to 12 points after 25 minutes. Stortford again fought back, but two forays into the Ampthill 22 were frustrated by penalties for fringing at rucks right on the try line.

The home side took full advantage of these escapes to work their way downfield , where further penalties were conceded by the visitors, the second also bringing a red card for Dan Leo for what was deemed a dangerous tackle, even though it was at knee level. This was shortly followed by another Ampthill try, as time was running out, when a badly-missed tackle allowed the home side's replacement scrum half to break from the back of a ruck and dash over from 20 yards out without a hand being laid on him. The conversion was missed and there was just enough time for Stortford to win a penalty of their own, which went to touch for a 5 metre lineout, from which the pack was able to drive over for a try to James Apperley. This, unfortunately proved to have been too little, too late, as Tom Banks' successful conversion was the last act of the game .



THIS IS NOW MY 5TH SEASON AT BISHOP'S STORTFORD. THAT TIME HAS ABSOLUTELY FLOWN.


We have seen and experienced so much as a group; some highs and lows along the way both individually and as a team. There are a few things that remain constant within our evolution; club ethos, commitment to the cause and a hunger to improve and develop.

As an 'outsider' (born and bred West Country boy) and relative journeyman in terms of number of other teams I have played for, BSRFC stands head and shoulders above the rest when it comes to ethos. The first thing I tell anyone about the team I play for is the pride I have when taking the field with 10 plus home grown lads every weekend. This is unique and in my mind one of our differentiators. We have a backbone built stronger than any other side we face. Resilience goes a long way on a rugby field. This has all been made possible by the support and community you have all created over 98 years, one I count myself fortunate to be part of.

This season has posed new challenges; new teams, new grounds, new faces, new patterns of play, the list goes on... We are constantly being pushed and challenged in unfamiliar ways. The commitment to the cause has been unwaivering throughout. We are at the 'semi' end of a 'semipro' league and our opponents today are more at the 'pro' end. This gives me great satisfaction, 95% of our team (few slackers) will have been up early. travelled an hour plus, worked hard and furthered their careers before travelling another hour plus to get to training. When you lose, when you have tough personal circumstances or when you are tired some clubs may start to falter. However the commitment shown by everyone in 1st and 2nd teams at BSRFC week in week out is exemplary and that breeds the right attitude for everyone to bounce off when they need to dig deep.

Playing in National 1 has forced us to raise

the bar continuously. This could have been a daunting task for some of us as time, energy and effort all need to increase in order to improve and develop. Huge credit must go to the coaches for giving us a framework in which we can do this. from strength and conditioning to 1-1 feedback sessions and more video reviews their approach has been professional and has delivered marginal gains. The part I have enjoyed most though is seeing the squad take responsibility for their own improvement and their own performances. Responsibility is a real buzz word in training at the moment and no one is shirking their role. You can feel the intensity at training has gone up a level and the standards we demand from one another are higher. It's exciting for the future as we are still a very young side (at 27 I feel like a senior citizen) and the potential of the group is enormous.

THE OVAL CLUB WAS FORMED IN 1998 BY A GROUP OF BSRFC MEMBERS WHO GOT TOGETHER TO TRY TO FIND A WAY OF RAISING FUNDS TO HELP THE PLAYING SIDE OF THE CLUB WITHOUT HAVING TO INCREASE DEBT OR UTILISE RESERVES. TO THIS END THE OVAL CLUB WAS FOUNDED WITH THE FOLLOWING MISSION STATEMENT:

'TO CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS PROMOTING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE STANDARD OF RUGBY THROUGHOUT BISHOP'S STORTFORD RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB'

The Oval Club is an autonomous body and entirely independent of the Rugby Club's operations. None of the Committee members hold a position or appointment in the Rugby Club's infrastructure. The Oval Club does not seek to influence decisions of the Rugby Club. It responds to requests for financial assistance for projects and purposes which have been approved by the Rugby Club's Executive Committee and which fall within its mission statement above.

Of the funds raised two thirds is set aside for the Rugby Club the other third is reserved to fund social events for Members.

To date the Oval Club has raised over £225,000 and the Rugby Club has received in excess of £138.000.

In line with its mission statement The Oval Club makes contributions for one off projects and purposes which are of long term value to the Rugby Club and not part of on-going budget requirements. Invariably contributions have been made to the Club to enable them to secure grants from the RFU and other sources.

So far, major contributions have been made towards the cost of :

- Pitch repair and maintenance,
- Improvement of the playing surfaces, including the purchase of a verti-drainer,
- Floodlighting the back field pitches,
- Drainage of the floodlit pitches,

- Replacement of goal posts,
- Playing equipment and travel costs for all teams.
- Purchase of physiotherapy equipment,
- Refurbishing the changing room showers.
- Supporting youth and mini through tours, kit and additional playing facilities,
- Junior coaching courses.

On the social side there are several Members' events which take place throughout each year for. Currently these are:

- A self-supporting golf day at one of the local golf clubs.
- An Annual Dinner and Forum
- A First Team Home lunch
- A First Team Away coach trip and lunch

Through its contributions The Oval Club plays a considerable part in helping the Rugby Club enhance its playing related facilities for the use and benefit of all members of the Club.
