NEWS FROM THE BLUES SYLVI RINGHOFER - BLUES SPORTS THERAPIST

How did you first get into Sports Therapy?

I got injured whilst training for my first marathon, and went to see George Cooper for some treatment, and having him fix me inspired me to want to the same for other people. So, I started working privately whilst also gaining some experience at the club which lead to looking after the Blues. Soon after which I ended up working with George!

Why BSRFC?

It was my local club where I was boxing at the time and was able to first get some hands-on Physio experience. I shadowed Sharon initially before being asked to take over the Blues role when she left the club in 2011. Weirdly the tape bill dropped significantly in that period!! Since then I've built up a really strong bond with all the Blues players over the years and am now very protective of them as if I were their mother! I definitely nag some of them like I am anyway!

Describe your typical week at the club?

Monday night we have appointments for any of the boys who picked up a knock on the Saturday. This used to be treated by many of the players as a perfect opportunity to just get a massage. Main culprit was definitely Sam Coleman, who has now been banned from Mondays!

My next duty is on Thursday nights when the boys train. Generally, just involves strapping them up before training, but also gives us an opportunity to treat injured players whilst the rest train.

Then Saturday comes back around and is obviously game day which starts with pre-game strapping and treatment, and then once the game kicks off, I run on and off the field with a massive bag trying to dodge 30 monsters!

Tell us about your best and worst patients!

Obviously, my favourite patient is my newly appointed Fiancé and Blues skipper Luke! He never fusses or tells me how to strap his ankles, just lets me do my job without any interference! (Much!)

Shout out to Deputy Scantlebury who always brightens my day with his funky underwear choices!

Ollie Jones wins worst patient for two reasons. First is because he steals all the crocodiles from our Physio container. The second is his horrible gremlin feet! (Sorry Ollie)

Special mention also to Ross Bird who constantly moans about me taping his leg hair over the shaved line....Such a wuss!

TOMORROW MORNING, A VERY TALENTED 22 MAN COLTS SQUAD WILL TAKE TO THE FIELD AT SOUTHEND IN THE SECOND LEG OF THE NATIONAL CUP.



They kicked off this year's campaign with a decisive win over Bedford Blues back in November, Since Christmas training has stepped up a gear or two with the national cup squad regularly running against the 1st XV and Blues to hone their structures and skills. We head east justifiably confident of moving ever closer to glory. The home side called the shots when it came to the timing of the fixture and the choice of the first weekend of half-term ruled out a number of talented individuals, although several players have underlined how important Stortford rugby is for them by changing their travel plans, booking new flights or opting to stay at home. Other players have stepped up to fill vacancies and it is very encouraging that we have so much strength in depth that the Colts can still field an exceptional side of boys with county, regional and national honours

And there really is strength in depth across the larger Colts squad. Stortford are one of only two clubs in the whole of the Hertfordshire and Middlesex leagues who can boast four teams across U17s and U18s with over 60 young men at play on some Sundays. The last weekend in January saw the U18Bs further both cup and league ambitions with a thrilling win over old rivals Tring in a double header. A gutsy, intelligent

and disciplined first 50 minutes turned into a try fest as the bigger opposition tired mentally and physically.

Last week, two U17s sides took to the field with outstanding defensive displays in both games. The Bs dominated second-placed Datchworth to take the bonus point and win their league with a game still in hand. Meanwhile the U17As got back to winning ways in the league with an edge-of-the-seat win over a very physical Harpenden side. Leading 24-10 with 15 mins to go we let our opponents back into the game and the scores were level at 24 all with just 2 mins to full time when Harpenden won a penalty in our 22. Thankfully, the ball dipped just under the posts and was touched down. The Stortford left wing Doree regathered from the 22 drop out and charged into the enemy's half. As the ball moved right from the breakdown, the ref signalled a penalty advantage to Stortford and with a free play, Stortford 10 Hawkins put in a perfect cross field kick which found Rees-Jones on the other wing: he stepped smoothly inside and glided over for the winning try. 

TODAY'S OPPOSITIONBIRMINGHAM MOSELEY RUGBY CLUB



MOSELEY WERE FOUNDED IN 1873 BY MEMBERS OF HAVELOCK CRICKET CLUB WHO WANTED SOMETHING TO DO IN THE WINTER MONTHS

A year later they adopted their famous red and black colours. They originally played at the Reddings in Moseley but the pressure of trying to compete in the new era of professional rugby caused them financial difficulties and created a need to sell their 125-year home to property developers. After a 5 year spell as tenants at the University of Birmingham they relocated to their current home at Billesley Common.

The Clubs so called 'Golden years' were in the 60's & 70's when their fixture list routinely included the top sides in England and Wales, and Moseley players were regularly included in international teams.

When league rugby commenced in 1987, Moseley were placed in the Courage National Division 1, the top division at the time and in 1988 they ended Bath's astonishing run of 22 unbeaten cup matches winning 4–3!

They were though relegated at the end of the 1990–1991 season. The club entered administration in 1998 and 4 years of financial turmoil followed before a new Moseley Rugby Club emerged in 2002. The rescue came too late though to save them on the field and that season they once again endured relegation this time to

National Two (Level 3)

They regained their spot in the second tier by finishing as champions in 2006 & there they remained until they were relegated to this league at the end of the 2015/16 season.

Prior to the 2016–17 season, the club changed its name to Birmingham Moseley Rugby Club.



SOLID FORWARDS PERFORMANCE ENOUGH TO SECURE NARROW WIN FOR STORTFORD IN TRICKY, DANK CONDITIONS.

The visitors got off to the worst possible start, when an early defensive error out wide gifted a two on one to lonians, which they grabbed with relish to put their right wing in for a try after only 2 minutes of the game, well converted by their flyhalf. Stortford responded positively and after a spell of pressure a good dart and kick ahead by Chris Smith took his side into the Ionians 22. Further pressure forced a penalty, from which Stortford opted for a scrum, off the back of which, Rory Banks seized on a loose ball to slide over for a try after 10 minutes, easily converted by George Cullen. Stortford were soon back on the attack and a tremendous driving maul, which took play some 20 yards and into the home 22 provided the platform for another try, when the ball was swung quickly to the right, where Nick Hankin ran a good outside arc to scythe between centre and wing to slide over for a try on 17 minutes. Cullen's conversion attempt went narrowly wide. The lead proved to be short-lived, though as one of a number of ill-targeted clearance kicks was punted back and a mix up between 2 Stortford defenders under the high ball allowed the ball to bounce free and two flykicks from Ionians' players put them in for an extremely soft try under the posts, the conversion taking the hosts 2 points ahead. Stortford again got onto the front foot and one of a number of scrum penalties was slotted by Cullen after 28 minutes to restore the narrowest of leads for the visitors. Ionians, though battled back into the Stortford 22, where a deliberate knock-on by Matt Riddington saw the centre vellow carded. The resultant penalty shot at goal, though came back off the upright and some sturdy defence saw out the half without points being conceded.

Despite starting with 14 men, Stortford dominated possession and territory for the first 10 minutes of the second half, but lacked the penetration to score and eventually conceded a penalty. Ionians were unable, though to retain possession and Stortford were soon back on the attack, winning a penalty, which Cullen converted to stretch the lead to 4 points after 15 minutes. The home side fought back and, showing greater penetration through their backs than Stortford had produced, put the visitors' line under pressure – aided by a number of unforced errors and a couple of penalties for offside. Some typically stout Stortford defending, though repelled the threat and the visitors had much the better of the remaining exchanges, but without really threatening to breach again the Ionians' line. With 5 minutes to go, though more Stortfod forward pressure forced another penalty and Cullen's unerring boot took his side out to a 7 point lead. Showing the benefit of lessons learned earlier in the season, the visitors saw out the remaining minutes in classical style, going through a few phases of driving forwards play to set up a pinpoint touch kick from Sam Coleman for touch well inside the Ionians' half and then bottling up the attempted counter.

This was a hard-fought, if dour victory, that brought a well-deserved end to a tough three-game losing streak.



'TO CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS PROMOTING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE STANDARD OF RUGBY THROUGHOUT BISHOP'S STORTFORD RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB'

The Oval Club is an autonomous body and entirely independent of the Rugby Club's operations. None of the Committee members hold a position or appointment in the Rugby Club's infrastructure. The Oval Club does not seek to influence decisions of the Rugby Club. It responds to requests for financial assistance for projects and purposes which have been approved by the Rugby Club's Executive Committee and which fall within its mission statement above.

Of the funds raised two thirds is set aside for the Rugby Club the other third is reserved to fund social events for Members.

To date the Oval Club has raised over £225,000 and the Rugby Club has received in excess of £138.000.

In line with its mission statement The Oval Club makes contributions for one off projects and purposes which are of long term value to the Rugby Club and not part of on-going budget requirements. Invariably contributions have been made to the Club to enable them to secure grants from the RFU and other sources.

So far, major contributions have been made towards the cost of :

- Pitch repair and maintenance,
- Improvement of the playing surfaces, including the purchase of a verti-drainer,
- Floodlighting the back field pitches,
- Drainage of the floodlit pitches,

- Replacement of goal posts,
- Playing equipment and travel costs for all teams.

- Refurbishing the changing room showers.
- Supporting youth and mini through tours, kit and additional playing facilities,
- Junior coaching courses.

1 Match. The day kicks off with a Q&A in the 1st XV Changing Room, followed by Training, Games & Warm up Sessions with the Coaches and Players. They then form the "Players Tunnel" alongside the "Blazers" to welcome both the opposition and the 1st XV onto the pitch before the game.
