WELCOME EVERYONE TO WHAT IS I BELIEVE THE FIRST TIME WE'VE PLAYED A 1ST XV MATCH ON A FRIDAY & CERTAINLY GOOD FRIDAY!

And of course a special welcome to the Players, Coaches, Officials & Supporters of the institution that is Blackheath FC, on this their first ever visit to our club. This of course is a rearranged fixture after the original date of 3rd March fell victim to the 'Beast from the East'. At that time this piece was going to begin with a comment about how difficult 2018 had been for us and whilst it's still fair to say that results haven't been entirely favourable there is no doubt that our performances since that postponement are much improved.

Our medical team led by Paul Sharma have managed to reduce our injured list significantly and it's no coincidence that the whole team now seem to be playing with more confidence & intensity.

Since we were last here on 10th February we've had three tough road trips. The first was a comparatively short jaunt around the M25 to leafy Surrey and a visit to Esher who are always a more formidable opponent at their own ground. So to emerge from the encounter victorious 25-16 was a very welcome outcome and one which if I'm honest I didn't really expect.

The following weekend we had an early kick off down at Plymouth Albion, who haven't lost on their own patch for over 12 months. Last Saturday we swapped 260 miles South for 220 North and a first ever experience of the Northern Echo Arena home of Darlington Mowden Park. For those who don't know it's a 25,000 all-seater stadium (the 2nd biggest Rugby stadium in England apparently) and watching & probably playing a game in such a space with less than 600 other souls, is I have to say a slightly surreal experience.

At least 150 of that 600 came from Stortford and I would once again like to pay tribute to the loyalty and commitment of our travelling support who were, as always quite superb. Nearly as good as the our players who once again put in a magnificent performance despite losing narrowly, in what was probably the best & fastest game I've ever seen a Stortford team participate in. It was a fantastic advert for Nat One.

On the morning of our last game here against Birmingham Moselev news reached us of the passing of one of our Distinguished & Honorary Life members and two-time past Chairman- Brian Gorman. It obviously came too late for me to include in my programme notes for that game, but it would be remiss of me not to belatedly acknowledge it today. Whilst Brian's face or name might not be familiar to many current members, Brian is to no small degree the reason they are able to enjoy the club as it is today. Green space or more accurately lack of it on which to accommodate our near 700 Mini & Youth players, is an ever present challenge for those on the Exec Committee. Can you imagine where we would be without access to the land at the rear of the clubhouse? Brian had the foresight to push ahead with the outright purchase of that land, when others doubted the wisdom of spending what was then a huge sum for us. (£7000). BSRFC LADIES - REASONS WHY MORE GIRLS AND WOMEN SHOULD TAKE UP CONTACT RUGBY



The Red Roses have dominated the headlines in the past couple of years. Their success in the Womens' World Cup and again in the Six Nations has proven that rugby is not just a sport for men. Despite this, some women are still hesitant to get their boots on and get involved with their local team.

Luckily, Bishop's Stortford Ladies' Team has stayed strong since the start and has managed to get a full team AND subs out to every single match in their first league. This success led to the launch of a brand-new girls' team which, despite being in the early stages, has attracted over 20 girls to each training session.

Here are some reasons that more girls and women (or anyone!) should get involved in contact rugby:

There's a Position for Everyone

Rugby is such an inclusive sport! It doesn't matter what shape, size or weight you are – there really is a position for everyone. Sometimes you might hear the odd comment: 'You don't look like you play rugby' – but honestly... who knows what a rugby player is 'supposed' to look like?

Fitness. Fitness. Fitness

It's such an intense workout. Sometimes going to the gym isn't for everyone, but rugby includes full body strength and cardio training - and you have a lot of fun while you're doing it!

Squad Goals

A rugby family is a real thing. You develop such a close bond with your team – and why shouldn't you, a lot of the time you're way closer (physically) than a lot of people are comfortable with. If you get tackled in a match your team mates are there to protect you - it doesn't stop as soon as you get off the pitch, if anything happens in life you can be pretty sure that your team will be there to pick you straight back up.

It's Pretty Empowering

There is nothing like the feeling you get when you have the ball and you're running down the pitch. Or the feeling you get when you make a great tackle. Even better if you get to experience scoring a try! Finishing a match and knowing that you've worked that hard feels like such an achievement – one that still feels worth it when your muscles ache and you find the bruises the next day!

Training for both the girls and ladies runs every Tuesday. The girls' sessions run from 6.15pm – 7.15pm. The women's sessions run from 7.15pm – 9pm.



TODAY'S OPPOSITION

BLACKHEATH FC



BLACKHEATH FOOTBALL CLUB WAS FOUNDED IN 1858 BY OLD BOYS OF BLACKHEATH PROPRIETARY SCHOOL WHO PLAYED A "CARRYING" GAME OF FOOTBALL MADE POPULAR BY RUGBY SCHOOL.

When the old boys played against the current pupils, supporters would shout for either "Club" or "School" accordingly. This is why to this day supporters of BFC shout for "Club", not for "Blackheath"

In 1863 the club developed the tactic of passing the ball from player to player as an alternative to the solo break and the "kick and follow-up". In 1863 Blackheath was a founder member of The Football Association which was formed at the Freemasons' Tavern, Great Queen Street, on Lincoln Inn Fields, London 26 October 1863 with the intention to frame a code of laws that would embrace the best and most acceptable points of all the various methods of play under the one heading of "football". Mr Francis Maule Campbell. a member of Blackheath, was elected treasurer. At the fifth meeting Campbell argued that hacking was an essential element of 'football' and that to eliminate hacking would "do away with all the courage and pluck from the game, and I will be bound over to bring over a lot of Frenchmen who would beat you with a week's practice." At the sixth meeting on 8th December Campbell withdrew Blackheath, explaining that the rules that the FA intended to adopt would destroy the game and all interest in it.

Other rugby clubs followed this lead and did not join the Football Association. In this way the great divide between soccer and rugby took place. In December 1870 Edwin Ash, secretary of Richmond Football Club published a letter in the papers which said, "Those who play the rugby-type game should meet to form a code of practice as various clubs play to rules which differ from others, which makes the game difficult to play." On 26 January 1871 a meeting attended by

representatives from 22 clubs was held in London at the Pall Mall Restaurant. As a result of this meeting the Rugby Football Union (RFU) was founded. The Club is one of seven of the original twenty-one clubs to have survived to this day.

Blackheath initially played its matches on the Heath (meeting and changing at the Princess of Wales public house) but occasional interruptions from spectators led the club to move, initially to a private field (Richardson's Field) in Blackheath before moving to the Rectory Field in 1883.

For the start of last season, after 158 years at Rectory Field, the Club moved to their training ground at Well Hall in Eltham.



DARLINGTON MOWDEN PARK 41 BISHOP'S STORTFORD FIRST XV 35

GREAT GAME OF FREE-FLOWING RUGBY SEES STORTFORD FALL NARROWLY SHORT OF WHAT WOULD HAVE BEEN A MEMORABLE VICTORY AWAY TO SECOND-PLACED DMP.

Confronted by possibly the best attacking team they have faced, Stortford found themselves 10 points behind with barely 5 minutes gone, as DMP's 15 man rugby and superb off-loading game made them almost impossible to defend against. An excellent converted try and penalty were the outcome and a lesser side than Stortford might have buckled at that stage. Instead, they fought back via a great leaping catch by Nick Hankin from a testing kick out of defence by the home side, from which Tom Banks drew the DMP winger and swapped passes with Sam Winter to run clear and touch down close to the posts with 15 minutes gone. George Cullen's conversion narrowed the gap to 3.

Although the home side continued to threaten, Stortford's swarming defence - epitomised by one 30 yard sprint by hooker, Dec Caulfield to cover-tackle a threatening DMP wing into touch - kept them in the game. After 20 minutes Cullen counter-attacked with a half break and, although his attempted offload dropped into space, Matt Riddington was able to volley it forward, before regathering and dashing under the posts for another converted try. DMP fought back and were threatening the Stortford line some 7 minutes later, when Ryan Hutler leapt to intercept a potential scoring pass and run virtually the length of the pitch for another 7 pointer The game had been played at a furious pace throughout and the home side registered another quality try to their right wing after some more excellent handling through multiple phases. Another outstanding conversion narrowed the gap to 4 points, but Stortford were not content to settle for a narrow lead and 3 minutes later Cullen spotted a gap behind the defensive line and chipped ahead from just outside the DMP 22 and just beat the cover defence to the touchdown. His own conversion took his side into a 28-17 halftime lead.

The home side once again started quickly after the break and, within 5 minutes had narrowed the deficit to 4 with yet another converted try. DMP continued to press and took three points from a penalty some 3 minutes later to bring them within one point of the visitors and pressed on from there. This time they needed a bit of good fortune as a 50:50 crossfield kick bounced back from the initial contest into the arms of the home side's winger for him to touch down with barely 10 minutes of the half gone. Another superb conversion from the touchline took DMP into a 6 point lead, but Stortford's dogged refusal to bow the knee prevented a rampant home side from extending the lead for another 25 minutes. Eventually, though the incisiveness of the home side's backs was made to tell again with another try out wide, followed by yet touchline conversion to stretch the lead to 13 points.

As Stortford have shown in previous matches, though they are never short of fight and, with less than 5 minutes to go, they duly launched themselves into the first concerted attack they had been able to muster in the second half. This was duly rewarded, with time almost up, as Rob Duff, came in off his wing to make a decisive break up the middle and found prop, Seb Brownhill in close support to gallop over for a try close to the posts. Cullen held his nerve to add the two points needed to secure the deserved second bonus point, triggering a huge reaction from the hundred or so Stortford supporters who had made the long journey north.



THE OVAL CLUB WAS FORMED IN 1998 BY A GROUP OF BSRFC MEMBERS WHO GOT TOGETHER TO TRY TO FIND A WAY OF RAISING FUNDS TO HELP THE PLAYING SIDE OF THE CLUB WITHOUT HAVING TO INCREASE DEBT OR UTILISE RESERVES. TO THIS END THE OVAL CLUB WAS FOUNDED WITH THE FOLLOWING MISSION STATEMENT:

'TO CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS PROMOTING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE STANDARD OF RUGBY THROUGHOUT BISHOP'S STORTFORD RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB'

The Oval Club is an autonomous body and entirely independent of the Rugby Club's operations. None of the Committee members hold a position or appointment in the Rugby Club's infrastructure. The Oval Club does not seek to influence decisions of the Rugby Club. It responds to requests for financial assistance for projects and purposes which have been approved by the Rugby Club's Executive Committee and which fall within its mission statement above.

Of the funds raised two thirds is set aside for the Rugby Club the other third is reserved to fund social events for Members.

To date the Oval Club has raised over £225,000 and the Rugby Club has received in excess of £138.000.

In line with its mission statement The Oval Club makes contributions for one off projects and purposes which are of long term value to the Rugby Club and not part of on-going budget requirements. Invariably contributions have been made to the Club to enable them to secure grants from the RFU and other sources.

So far, major contributions have been made towards the cost of :

- Pitch repair and maintenance,
- Improvement of the playing surfaces, including the purchase of a verti-drainer,
- Floodlighting the back field pitches,
- Drainage of the floodlit pitches,

- Replacement of goal posts,
- Playing equipment and travel costs for all teams.
- Purchase of physiotherapy equipment,
- Refurbishing the changing room showers.
- Supporting youth and mini through tours, kit and additional playing facilities,
- Junior coaching courses.

On the social side there are several Members' events which take place throughout each year for. Currently these are:

- A self-supporting golf day at one of the local golf clubs.
- An Annual Dinner and Forum
- A First Team Home lunch
- A First Team Away coach trip and lunch

Through its contributions The Oval Club plays a considerable part in helping the Rugby Club enhance its playing related facilities for the use and benefit of all members of the Club.






