We often forget that they themselves have their own careers, social lives and hobbies to enjoy, however they put this all aside season on season for us to play rugby.

For so many of the better halves or family of the players, the ordeal of living with a semi-professional rugby player begins on a Saturday night putting up with dirty kit strewn across the house. Next will come nursing a bear with a sore head on the Sunday, either through too many beers celebrating another famous Stortford win or the grumpy mood swings of a player who didn't get the right result from the game played. Monday's through to Thursday's, these incredible ladies cope effortlessly without their male counterparts for most of the evenings and then turn out again on the Saturday to lend their support to the boys playing, or those not through times of injury.

Ladies, it is difficult to pen everything that you do for us, however we would like to extend a very sincere and public thank you to the women of Bishop's Stortford Rugby Club for all of your support of the players this season. We hope that you enjoy today's Ladies Day for Target Ovarian Cancer, and all the prosecco!

Finally, a huge shout out to those making up the current Bishop's Stortford Girls & Ladies teams, with a fantastic win ratio of 6 wins in 9 games so far, really proving that this girl can!



TODAY'S OPPOSITIONFYLDE



FYLDE RUGBY CLUB WAS FOUNDED ON 25 JULY 1919, LITERALLY ON THE TOSS OF A COIN WHEN A GROUP OF MANCHESTER BUSINESSMEN MET IN ANSDELL TO DISCUSS THE FORMATION OF EITHER A RUGBY UNION OR A FOOTBALL CLUB.

A coin was tossed and it fell in favour of rugby union. The club grew steadily and had achieved a strong fixture list by the 1960s. It has been in the National Leagues since their inception in 1987.

Their home venue is the Woodlands Memorial Ground on Blackpool Road in Ansdell. They currently field four senior teams with their Wanderers, Saracens and Vandals playing in the North West Leagues.

They were promoted back into National League One in 2011 and have finished as high as 3rd (in 2013/14 season) but last season finished 12th. Unfortunately their relegation this season was confirmed on 10th March when they lost 36-5 at Blackheath.

Many famous players have graced their shirt but perhaps the most illustrious is current World Rugby Chairman, ex RFU president & Question of Sport team captain Bill Beaumont CBE. Remarkably Flyde was the only club Beaumont ever played for! Having joined Fylde as a 17-year-old in 1969 he stayed with the club until injury forced him to retire in 1982. His first game for them was in their 6th team at fullback. He eventually went on to win 34 England caps between 1975 and 1982, 21 of them as captain. This included leading the side to the Grand

Slam in 1980, as well as skippering the 1980 British Lions tour to South Africa.

Despite their position in the table Fylde have been no push overs this season, as we found out when we visited there for the first (& hopefully not the only) time in early December. They have a very young, predominantly home grown squad who play with a lot of pride & spirit. They have worked hard to retain all their players for next season, so hopefully their stay in National Two North will only be temporary.



BISHOP'S STORTFORD FIRST XV 15 BLACKHEATH 5

DESPITE BLACKHEATH'S OBVIOUS WEIGHT ADVANTAGE IN THE PACK, STORTFORD COPE WITH THE HORRENDOUS CONDITIONS OF HORIZONTALLY POURING RAIN BETTER, TO DOG OUT A GREAT WIN.

It looked in the early stages as if the big visiting forwards would be decisive in conditions clearly favouring tight rugby in this match, sponsored by great Club supporters, Harlow Agricultural Merchants (HAM). Prospects, therefore looked good for Blackheath to maintain their record for the season of not having lost twice to the same side.

They certainly convinced the referee that they had an edge, as he awarded two penalties at successive scrums against the Stortford front row before the ball had gone in - even though the pack subsequently managed to scrummage legally through completed scrums. Blackheath exploited this initial advantage to the full and went through several phases of forward drives, before switching the ball to the open spaces and one good long pass was enough to send flanker, Harry Bate in for a try out wide on 10 minutes, after the home defence had been sucked in. The conversion attempt went wide and Stortford bounced straight back to get onto the front foot and, eventually, courtesy of a penalty of their own at a breakdown, won a lineout well inside the Blackheath 22. A classic catch and drive was executed to see Dec Caulfield driven over for an equalising try after 20 minutes, with George Cullen's attempted conversion falling just short. The rest of the half was spent in a midfield armwrestle with neither side being able to establish an advantage in the appalling conditions, leaving the scores deservedly level at the break.

Stortford started the second period strongly and persisted, despite the weather to attempt to move the ball around with some initial success and were eventually rewarded, when Cullen converted a penalty to take his side into a 3 point lead after 9 minutes. From the restart, Blackheath moved onto the attack and had worked their way well into the Stortford 22, when Will Roberts was penalised and arguably, rather harshly sin-binned for a high tackle as he slid in to a cover tackle.

At this stage, the writing appeared to be on the wall, but Stortford held out two successive Blackheath scrums and then produced some typically dogged, backs to the wall defence, as the visitors launched drive after drive at their line. Eventually, the solid defensive wall forced a breakdown penalty, which proved to be a major turning point. Stortford slowly ground their way up field again and, having seen out the sin bin period, established a clear advantage at the set scrum, managing to take two balls against the head. This and some controlled handling put them on the front foot inside the visitors' half and a spell of quick handling through a series of short passes to the flood of supporting players finally forced a breach in the Blackheath defence and Seb Brownhill was able to crash over under the posts for a try, which Cullen duly converted to take their side out to a 10 point lead with 15 minutes to go.

The visitors never really looked like coming back from this deficit and time was duly seen out to send the massive crowd of home supporters who had braved the foul weather to cheer on their side back to the bar with smiles on their faces. The Man of the Match award, donated by our loyal Colts' sponsors, Charterhouse Voice and Data went to Will Roberts against his old team, though it could probably have gone to any of the 11 forwards for their tremendous collective performance - or indeed to any of backs for their heroism in sticking manfully to their tasks in the bone-chilling conditions, which inevitably restricted their roles.

When it comes to supporting our local rugby club, we're in the front row.



DUE TO BEING 'BIG BONED' BUT MAINLY LIFESTYLE CHOICES I HAVE BEEN RESTRICTED TO PLAYING IN THE FRONT ROW FOR NEARLY ALL MY PLAYING CAREER,

apart from a brief stint in the second row at u17 level mainly due to the fact I was the tallest prop we had and a shortage of second rows.....

My earliest memories of rugby were at TBSHS. The cold, wet & windy early Saturday mornings at Jobbers Wood plodding around in a heavy long sleeve cotton rugby shirt will always live in the memory. I joined BSRFC when I was 16 and became part of the National title winning sides at u17 and colts level in consecutive years.

I even managed to play a few games against the Banks brothers, George Cullen, Ross Johnstone & Johnny Neville in the renowned Stan Calvert varsity. Safe to say I came out on top on all 3 occasions.

Whilst in my final year at University Longy got in contact with me due to a shortage of props and asked if I've come back. My first 1st XV game was in December 2014 against Canterbury at Silver Leys in a tight loss and I spent the rest of the season travelling down from Newcastle to play on Saturdays. Apart from playing the odd 2nd XV game whilst I was back from University this was my first experience of men's rugby. It was a bit of a wakeup call compared to playing University rugby and I soon realised I'd have to shed a bit of weight and improve my conditioning if I wanted to continue playing at that level or above.

I have now amassed over 100 games for the 1st XV, playing my 100th game at Birmingham Moseley this year in a great win. This season has been extremely enjoyable on and off the pitch, I think we have now realised that we are more than capable of becoming a top 4 side in National 1

for years to come. Having such great travelling support no matter where we are playing really does make a difference on the pitch.

The highlight of my playing career so far would have to be our title winning season last year and the great scenes after the Exmouth game, especially in the changing room. Last season was made even more enjoyable by playing alongside some of my closest mates who I've grown up playing with in Tom Banks, Jack Scantlebury, Rory Young, George Cullen & Will Roberts.

'TO CONTRIBUTE TOWARDS PROMOTING THE HIGHEST POSSIBLE STANDARD OF RUGBY THROUGHOUT BISHOP'S STORTFORD RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB'

The Oval Club is an autonomous body and entirely independent of the Rugby Club's operations. None of the Committee members hold a position or appointment in the Rugby Club's infrastructure. The Oval Club does not seek to influence decisions of the Rugby Club. It responds to requests for financial assistance for projects and purposes which have been approved by the Rugby Club's Executive Committee and which fall within its mission statement above.

Of the funds raised two thirds is set aside for the Rugby Club the other third is reserved to fund social events for Members.

To date the Oval Club has raised over £225,000 and the Rugby Club has received in excess of £138.000.

In line with its mission statement The Oval Club makes contributions for one off projects and purposes which are of long term value to the Rugby Club and not part of on-going budget requirements. Invariably contributions have been made to the Club to enable them to secure grants from the RFU and other sources.

So far, major contributions have been made towards the cost of :

- Pitch repair and maintenance,
- Improvement of the playing surfaces, including the purchase of a verti-drainer,
- Floodlighting the back field pitches.
- Drainage of the floodlit pitches,

- Replacement of goal posts.
- Playing equipment and travel costs for all teams.
- Purchase of physiotherapy equipment,
- Refurbishing the changing room showers.
- Supporting youth and mini through tours, kit and additional playing facilities,
- Junior coaching courses.

- A First Team Away coach trip and lunch
