PRESIDENT'S WELCOME

I'd like to extend a warm welcome to all visitors to Silver Leys today, particularly to the players, coaches, officials and supporters of Loughborough for today's 1st XV match. I must also welcome Mark Prisk, our local M.P. Mark has given the club his valuable support over the past few years and no doubt we will tap him up again at some time in the future – and of course, we'll all vote for him! Also, good to see James and Ryan Palmer from Palmer and Martin here as man of the match sponsors, and Russell Property, as they continue their sponsorship of the Match Day Experience.

Unfortunately for Loughborough, they currently sit bottom of the league. Unfortunately for Stortford we are only two positions above them! Loughborough have yet to win a game, whilst Stortford have notched up just the one victory so far. Last week's game up at Sale, it started very brightly for us, but we then suffered a catastrophic yellow card, conceding 19 points in the 10 minutes. COLTS REPORT ROUND-UP

With just three weeks to go until the first round of the Colts National Cup, preparations continue to go well. Last weekend saw the League campaigns get underway against Enfield Ignatians and London Welsh, with Stortford coming out on top in both games by a healthy margin. With several players vying for each position in the National Cup squad, including many with representative honours, the future looks bright.

Training on Thursday evenings will grow ever more challenging in the coming weeks as the Colts will regularly run out against the 1st XV and Blues to practice their defensive and attacking shapes. The intention this season has been to align Colts ever more closely with the Seniors and throughout the first half of the season all players have been introduced to elements of the Senior play book, defensive systems, techniques and vocabulary. It has been a big ask, but the boys have met the challenge head on.

Director of Colts Rugby Andre Beukes is supported by a team of four coaches: Richard Bedford, Jim Bloxham, Bruce Belton and Chris Hadley, but the real heroes of the team are the management: Diane Basavaraj, Simon Wilson, Andy Beer and Brian Mitchell. For the past two seasons, Stortford have put player welfare at the



top of their list of priorities. This means that boys who play for school on a Saturday are not allowed to play for the club on a Sunday. This presents some tricky last-minute challenges for the team managers who now have to align both fixtures and selection to school rugby – fortunately they are spreadsheet magicians and have so far managed to field teams every Sunday.

The boys would welcome a sea of blue on the touchline at 12.30 on 21st of October when they take on Saracens Amateurs Away.



TODAY'S OPPOSITION LOUGHBOROUGH STUDENTS REC



The history of Loughborough Students RFC actually predates the formation of the University when the students of what was then Loughborough College formed what is considered the original side in September 1919.

As you might expect for certainly one of, if not the pre-eminent sports university in the UK they have a rich & illustrious list of rugby alumni. Which includes at least 17 former British & Irish Lions & many more full internationals. Fran Cotton, Gerald Davies, John Dawes, Eric Miller, Ben Kay & Sir Clive Woodward have all worn their famous colours.

In 1976, the Student's Unions of the University of Technology and the Loughborough Colleges merged and the Loughborough Students Rugby Club was formed. The eventually joined the RFU league structure in 1996 at the bottom of the league

system. By the end of the 2006 /07 season they had reached Midlands 1 (Level 5) & in their first season were promoted to Level 4- National 3 North (now National 2 North).

In 2012 they were crowed champions of National 2 North securing promotion to National One. They finished a very creditable 7th in their first season at Level 3. In the subsequent five seasons they finished between 11th & 13th

Last season whilst we defeated them here in December 43-12, the students exacted revenge in April when finishing victorious 32-14 in the return fixture.

Like ourselves they have had a 'difficult' start to this current campaign, losing their first four fixtures. The most recent of which was a 8-39 reversal at home to Cinderford.

MATCH REPORT

Stortford rue missed opportunities, as they go down to defeat against an experienced Sale side.

Stortford got off to a guick start and were 5 points ahead within 2 minutes, with the home side apparently caught cold. Quick hands across the Stortford backs gave Rob Duff on the right wing a bit of space, allowing him to get round the outside of his opposite number and an accurate pass inside saw Sam Winter bursting over the line for an unconverted try. The visitors remained on the front foot and extended their lead with 5 minutes gone with a George Cullen penalty. Sale rallied, though and scored their own penalty goal after 11 minutes for what seemed to be a harsh penalty for not releasing at a tackle, though the attacking player appeared not to have gone to ground before the ball was ripped free. As the game went on, the home side gained a slight edge, enjoying an increasing share of possession. It was Stortford, though that came close to scoring again after 26 minutes, when a break up the middle by Winter put his side on the front foot, but a knock-on close to the opposition line snuffed out the threat. Stortford continued to press, but two poor tactical kicks allowed Sale to counter-attack, leading to the major turning point of the game, when Cullen was yellow carded on 30 minutes for a deliberate knock-on. The home side drove home the one man advantage immediately, driving over from a 5 metre lineout to level the scores and showed the benefit of their extra experience over the next 10 minutes in scoring two more converted

tries by driving repeatedly up the middle through their powerful forwards, before switching the ball quickly wide for their very skilful back three to exploit the visitors' stretched back line.

The value of the 19 points added during the yellow card period became increasingly evident, as the second half progressed, with Stortford appearing increasingly frustrated, as a combination of stout Sale defence and crucial handling and alignment errors foiled a series of threatening attacks. James Apperley, Sam Winter and Seb Brownhill showed up prominently for the visitors, but the home side also came close to a couple of scores on the counter and were undoubtedly deserved winners after a scoreless second half. This was a remarkable outcome, with both sides looking to attack at every opportunity, but two strong defences ultimately came out on top. On the balance of opportunities Stortford could feel disappointed that they had not at least gone away with a losing bonus point against a well organised side, including a number of outstanding players - notably their loosehead, Adam Aigbokhae, who constantly threatened with ball in hand around the fringes, number 7, ex international, David Seymour in the thick of things at the breakdown and winger, Paulo Odogwu threatening whenever he got his hands on the ball, as might be expected from a player, who had appeared for Sale Sharks in the Premiership last week.
